Lady Eve of Lynn

I finished reading Dorothy Dunnett's *The Lymond Chronicles*, right before Thanksgiving. Just in time to start the Holiday round of baking, shopping and the rest of the end of the year festivities.

The Lymond chronicles were first published between 1961 and 1975. The series follows the adventures of Frances Crawford of Lymond for ten years. Most of the tale takes place during the reign of Queen Mary Tudor.

The Game of Kings introduces the reader to this Scottish outlaw out to clear his name.

Queens Play Takes Francis Crawford to France to protect the child Queen Mary.

In *The Disorderly Knights* our hero fights the Turkish corsairs and a villain found within the ranks of the Knights Hospitable. *Pawn In Frankincense* :Lymond is in search of a kidnapped child , cuts a path across the Ottoman empire of Suleiman the Magnificent.

The Ringed Castle takes Frances to the Russia of Ivan the Terrible were he tried in vain to bring order to the country.

Lymond returns to France to lead an army against England and Spain in *Checkmate* the last book in the series.
